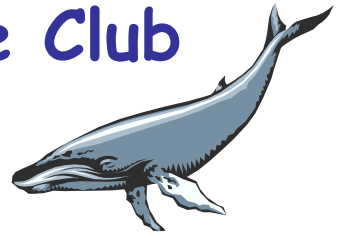




New England Aquarium Dive Club Annual Whale Watch Sunday, April 11, 2010

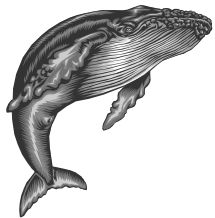
